

Title page form

The title page should be submitted separately from the article. The guidelines should be followed and the respective fields completed:

Article title:

The title should reflect the content of the article. In some situations it should reference the design of the study, for example, randomized clinical trials, systematic reviews, and meta-analyses. It should contain no more than 17 words. If it includes a subtitle, the combined length should not exceed 21 words.

Authors:

Author name and initials	Academic Degree	Affiliation	ORCID ID

Information on all authors: Name used in scientific publications; academic degree; affiliations - institution(s) where they work and/or research center they belong (maximum 3); ORCID identification.

Authors' contributions:

Author's initials	Contribution

Indication of the contribution of each author with the designation of the initials of each of them, referring to: Conception and design of the study; data collection; data analysis and interpretation; statistical analysis; obtaining funding; drafting the manuscript; critical review of the manuscript.

Corresponding Author	Details

Corresponding author: Full name; email address, institutional address, phone number.

Total number of words in the article, excluding bibliographical references, tables, charts, and figures
